Editors' Pen

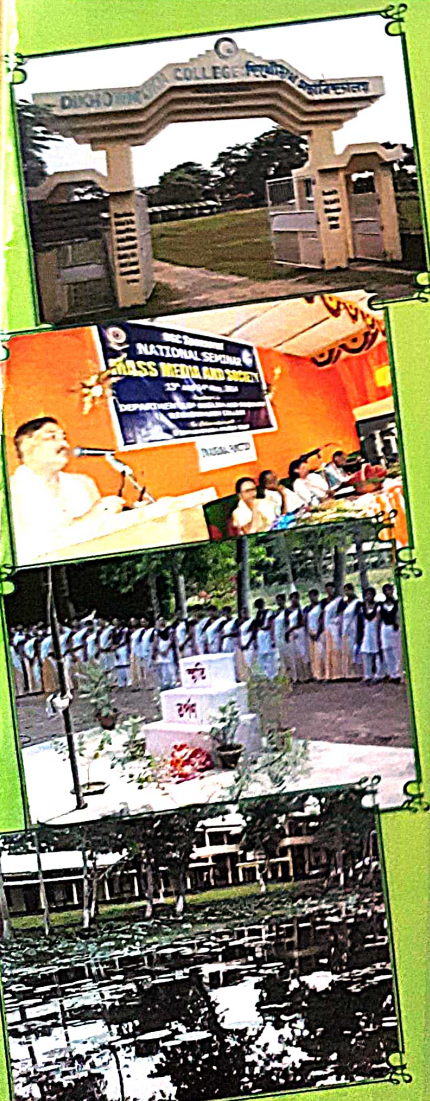

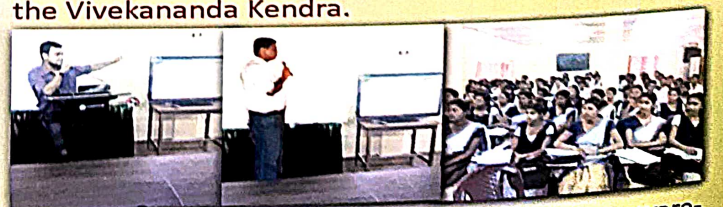
Besides academia, the college very often encourages multi-disciplinary awareness programmes for the stu-

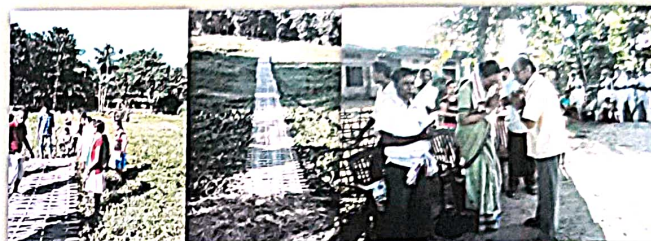

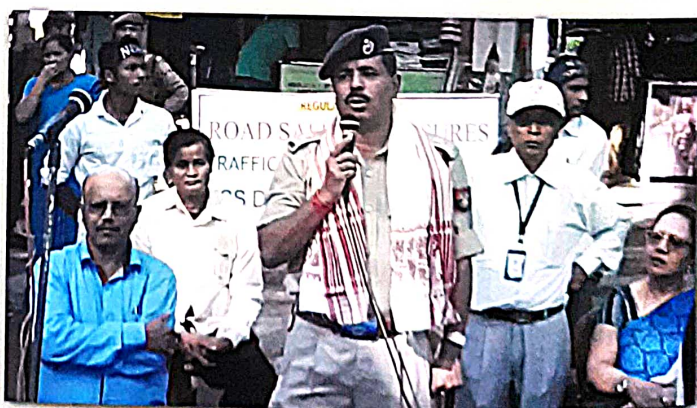
NSS Activities:

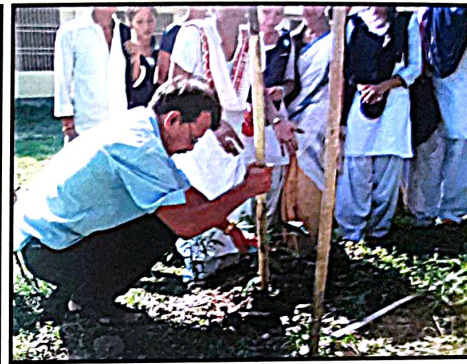
