Shankardev's Vaishnavism (also known as the eksharan-naam-dharma) was not just a religious phenomenon, but a significant socio-cultural turn for the people of the Brahmaputra Valley and its neighbouring areas, and has remained relevant ever since its inception in the 15th-16th century. It is imperative that the cultural fabric of Assam today is woven with the threads of Shankardev's philosophy and its multiple forms of institutional propagation.

How does it remain ever so relevant? In what ways does his ek-sharan-naam-dharma thrive today, and shape the lives of the people here? This seminar encourages the students to ask and seek answers for many such questions. The idea of the seminar is to train students in writing basic academic papers and step into the arena of research. It will bring forward a range of themes for students to choose from, which will introduce them with different facets of Mahapurush Shankardev's life and philosophy.
