About the Seminar

Education is a process by which a person's body, mind and character are formed and strengthened. It is a bringing of head, heart and mind together and thus enabling a person to develop an all round personality identifying the best in him or her. The National Education Policy (NEP) is a policy formulated by the Government of India to promote a quality education amongst Indians. The first education policy was promulgated by the Government of India by Prime Minister Indira Gandhi in 1968, the second by Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi in 1986, and the third by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2020. To implement NEP successfully at all levels the Government will need to create stakeholder as incentives so that the implementation is smooth and uniform. Formulate instruments in the form of legal, Policy, regulatory and Institutional mechanisms. For successful implementation we should provide professional development for teachers. We should update textbooks and other learning materials. Creation of a supportive environment for learning and curriculum design should be given more priority. Similarly, increasing analytical and cognitive ability and will be required in the impactful execution of knowledge. The holistic development is an important part of it which can be achieved with the balance work of theoretical learning and execution of this knowledge for the benefit of society. This will fulfill the outcome-based education purpose of this policy. NEP also provides an open sky for the students with MOOCs and industrial partnerships which ultimately provide the space of work in different directions. The idea of Institutions of Eminence articulated by the Prime Minister contains the vision to develop world-class universities in India. Use technology to support implementation. Conduct a needs assessment. For successful implementation we should create Industry Institute collaboration. There should be provision of exit options in degree courses, academic Bank of credit, teacher eligibility. Thus, the national education policy 2020 aims to take this learning outside of the four walls of a classroom and encourage students to imbibe from the real world.
